For your child's safety during daily Physical Education class, it is important that your child wear a tight fitting athletic shoe, versus a casual street shoe or boot. It is recommended that shoes be fastened for a tight fit, preferably with shoe laces that are laced up tight and tied daily. Many of the zip up shoes, slip on shoes, and skateboard type shoes lack the tight fit or support often resulting in kids literally running/kicking right out of their shoes, tripping, and twisting ankles. Shoes with wheels are also unsafe and not allowed during PE class or at any time at Cokato Elementary.
