ASA Fastpitch Programs

10 and Under & 12 and Under (Gr. 3-4 & 5-6)

Playing time is as equal as possible at the 10U & 12U levels. These levels will stress basic instruction of softball skills. The emphasis is placed on fun and learning introductory skills. Teams will not be grouped by ability. Players will participate in practices and league games as well as tournament play. (Note: Playing time will be impacted by attendance at practice and disciplinary actions.)

14 and Under (Gr. 7-8)-A & B Level Teams

At the 14U and above levels, many girls have developed skills at specific positions. While coaches will make every effort to assure all players get quality innings, primary position players will likely get more innings than other players. Girls that develop as pitchers and catchers will get more playing time because their positions demand that they be on the field.

At this level, players will be provided with advanced instruction of softball skills. Emphasis will be placed on more detailed instruction of fundamental skills. Fair playing time during league play will be emphasized, however, during tournaments playing time will depend on game situations. Playing time will NOT be equal on the "A" level team(s). Players will participate in practices and league games as well as tournament play.

16 and Under (Gr. 9-10)

At this level, players will be provided with advanced instruction of softball skills. Players at this level are expected to be dedicated to the program. Emphasis will be placed on more detailed instruction of fundamental skills. Fair playing time during league play will be emphasized, however, during tournaments playing time will depend on game situations. Playing time will not be equal. Coaches will be expected to recognize the strengths and weaknesses of each player, utilize their strengths, and work toward eliminating their weaknesses. Players will participate in practices and league games as well as tournament play.

18 and Under (Gr. 11-Age 19)

At this level, players will be provided with advanced instruction of softball skills. Players at this level are expected to be dedicated to the program. Emphasis will be placed on detailed instruction of fundamental skills. Fair playing time during league play will be emphasized, however, during tournaments playing time will depend on game situations. Playing time will not be equal.

For 19 year olds to be eligible for 18U they must turn 19 after January 1, 2011. *(There will be another opportunity for 3rd & 4th graders this summer to play in an in-house league if they prefer not to participate in this more competitive option.)* To sign up for the 10U ASA League it is suggested that the participant has prior softball experience.
